# Staying updated about the weather all over the world

- Show and distribute the students the International weather. report and give them 10-15 minutes to do it
- Make the board game weather together with the class. Use a digital roller dice.

### 5 (Lesson 5-50 min)

## Most common English Weather Idioms

- Show the English Weather Idioms video and let the students make notes of the different idioms about the weather.
- Match the sentences with the weather idioms to their explanations.
- Do the weather vocabulary quiz and let the class answer

## Culminating Task: The Autumn / Winter Weather Forecast

- As a class, combine different pictures together (e.g. snow / wind / cold). Have children create groups of simple phrases using the different combinations into a short weather report. Groups will compete with each other for which group can combine more pictures and phrases. Ask each group to say their weather report out loud by pointing to the different pictures they've used in order.
- Next, ask each group to think of a fun activity to do (skiing / playing outside / going to school)
- Each child takes turns pretending to be the weather report. Other students will ask the weather watcher what the weather will be like today or tomorrow. The weather watcher replies with their choice of weather (e.g. "It will snow. It will be nasty weather"). The other children think about their activity and show how they feel about the weather (thumbs up - happy / thumbs down - sad). For example, if it is nasty weather, they will be sad because they can't play outside.

*Note:* You may wish to repeat this activity with a focus on the past tense (i.e. what was and was not possible to do because of the weather).
